Charlotte, NC
July 9-14, 2012

This trip is intended for all students who are entering 7-9th grade in Fall 2010.

This trip is also opened to high school students who have completed a leadership application and interview.

Where Are We Going?

We are headed to Charlotte, NC to serve with Travis and Jessica Jones and Missionary Athlete International. The Middle School Ministry is pleased to serve with Travis and Jessica after having served with them in Niagara Falls in 2010.

What Will We Do in Charlotte?

Our goal is to partner with MAI in the three neighborhoods of Grier Heights, Birchcroft, and Woodbridge. Through sports ministry, Vacation Bible School and light construction, we will serve these communities and the families in need. In these neighborhoods we will have the opportunity to love, disciple, and empower the youth.

Who Will We Work With?

Our trip will be hosted by Travis and Jessica Jones and Missionary Athlete International. MAI has been active for over 25 years (www.maisoccer.com). The focus of MAI is to communicate the message of Jesus Christ through the environment of soccer. We will help to accomplish this by doing sports ministry. Throughout the year, Travis and Jessica and other missionaries work with local churches to offer tutoring, ESL, Bible Studies, and material needs such food, furniture and appliances. We are excited to join in the already formed relationships with the residents of these three neighborhoods!

Where Will We Stay?

We will be staying in a Presbyterian Church just minutes away from our job sites. There are showers on site and also air conditioning. The facility has a kitchen where we will prepare our own meals. There are also enough beds for almost everyone, but some will need to sleep on air mattresses.

What are the dates of the 2012 MS/HS Summer Mission Project?

Dates: July 9-14. We will travel by the CPC van, bus and personal vehicles. Chaperones that have a desire to go will need to talk to Nicole. It is helpful if they are willing to drive their personal vehicles, preferably 7-passenger vehicles.

What Will This Cost?

Approximately \$250-\$300. The exact total will be finalized as registration draws to a close. The fee includes transportation, food, program materials and lodging. It also includes training and program materials.

IMPORTANT: All team members and chaperones are required to complete 6 hours of training prior to our departure as well as participate in ALL fundraisers.

How does one Register?

MS Participants must fill out the registration form no later than January 15. **Parents** must also fill out a parent form—to be turned in at the same time as the student registration. **HS Participants** must fill out a leadership application (due no later than December 7) and complete an interview. HS Participants will also need to attend additional training and planning meetings. Please include your \$50 deposit (with MS/HS SMP written in the memo line). Registration may be done online.
