٧	CPC Session requested National Capital Presbytery (NCP) Leadership Council (LC) send a delegation to Session to address concerns of the Session and congregation about General Assembly actions.
٧	Session requested a second delegation to discuss the remaining distress leading to conversation on the possibility of leaving the PCUSA
٧	Session requested the appointment of a Discernment Team from Presbytery to consult with the Session and congregation over a period of several months to consider options and discern whether to seek dismissal.
V	The Discernment Team in consultation with the Session concluded that CPC wished to request dismissal from PCUSA and recommended to the Leadership Council that an informational meeting of the congregation be held so that the congregation can take an advisory vote on whether to request dismissal. The LC has not yet responded to the request to schedule the advisory vote.
	LC provided CPC Session with the terms it has set for the allocation of assets to NCP. Session accepted these terms and is awaiting a response from LC.
	Next Steps in the Process:
	Public notice will be given to all active members of the congregation in advance of the informational meeting during which the advisory vote is taken
	If no less than 60% of active membership votes and no less than 80% of those individuals vote to request dismissal, then Leadership Council will bring the outcome to NCP along with the agreement on the allocation of assets to the next presbytery meeting for a final up or down vote.
	Clerk of Session will provide Presbytery the contact information for any members who wish to stay in the PCUSA
	Once CPC is dismissed from PCUSA we will join ECO
