



Children's Ministry Internship Position Description

Purpose

1. To grow in spirituality, character development, and ministry skills.
2. To gain experience in all areas of children's ministry.
3. To serve Centreville Presbyterian Church in practical ways toward the spiritual growth of its children.

Qualifications

The Children's Ministry Intern shall:

1. Be a spirit-filled disciple of Jesus Christ.
2. Be seeking to grow in his/her character and ministry skills.
3. Demonstrate an openness to explore the possibility of full-time ministry.

Organization

The Children's Ministry Intern shall be:

1. Directly accountable to the Director of Children's Ministry (DCM) via weekly meetings.
2. Indirectly accountable to other CPC staff and the parents of the children.

Duties

Personal:

1. Maintain a daily time alone with God in prayer and devotion.
2. Work 10-15 hours per week over a 12-week period late May – early August. Intern is expected to be at all children's ministry camps.
This is a paid internship – \$2,000 for the summer
3. Regularly attend CPC worship services.

Teaching and Preparation:

1. Assist in preparation for Sunday morning classes.
2. Assist teaching teams on Sunday mornings and lead as needed.
3. Assist in preparing and leading CPCKids summer events including CPCKids camp.

Administration and meetings:

1. Attend staff meetings every Tuesday (12 noon to 2pm).
2. Attend one Children's Leadership meeting.
3. Be available to assist the DCM in administrative duties or activities.

Relationship Building:

1. Seek to build strong relationships with the children, parents, other members of the congregation and staff. Intern is expected to greet children on Sunday morning Check In.
2. Set solid, Christ-filled examples to all those around you.
