



**NOTE:**

1. Employees or volunteers who operate a 15-passenger van while conducting activities for, or in behalf of the insured, must have a Commercial Driver's License (CDL), OR taken and passed a Defensive Driving Course.
2. Drivers should be between the ages of 25 and 70.
3. It is recommended that **ALL** employees and volunteers who drive their personal vehicles for insured activities have minimum liability limits of \$100,000/\$300,000/\$100,000.
4. Driver must have **NO** major moving violation and **NO MORE THAN ONE** minor moving violation for the prior three years. See below for list of violations.

<b>MAJOR</b>	<b>MINOR</b>
Driving while intoxicated or under the influence of drugs.	Speed Equal to less than 10 mph over the limit.
Failure to stop and report accident involvement.	Moving violation resulting in filing of evidence of Financial Responsibility.
Homicide/Assault while operating a vehicle.	Altered license or unlawful use of license or permit.
Driver's license suspended, revoked, cancelled, or barred.	Driving on the wrong side of the road or in the wrong direction.
Violation of Open Container Law.	Any passing violation.
Possession of alcohol or drugs.	School bus or school zone.
Motor vehicle theft.	Failures to yield at intersection, stop sign, or traffic device.
Manslaughter or vehicular homicide.	Failure to yield to emergency vehicle.
Carrying a concealed weapon.	
Felony use of a motor vehicle.	
Careless/reckless driving.	
Drag racing or participating in speed contests.	
Speed in excess of 10 mph over the limit.
